Fred has represented Sweden and has been on the gold medal winning team. He is an accredited trainer and works with many top riders in show jumping and eventing. He was also one of the trainers on the television series 'Only Fools on Horses'! Fred has developed a modern, systematic approach which includes a clear understanding between pupil and trainer. His enthusiasm and technical clarity help riders to move on and achieve their ambitions.

Each training session will last 1 ½ hours. During this clinic you will work on Show Jump course riding, by practising a variety of exercises, this will help any horse and rider partnership to gain confidence and skills. The clinics will be split up into groups which are matched on rider ability and the height at which they are jumping.

Summer House Equestrian Centre has a fantastic 75 x 25 all-weather indoor school. Being a very popular BSJA venue they have an excellent variety of fences. With easy access from the M5 at junction 12 this makes it the perfect venue to reach. All abilities are catered for and matched into groups based on the information you provide.

Terms and Conditions

1. Horse/Pony sports are dangerous. Neither the Professional Equine Training committee, nor any persons acting on their behalf, nor the landowner can accept any liability for loss, damage, accident or injury to any persons, horses or property.
2. It is compulsory that all riders wear hats/helmets up to British Standard Riding Hats conforming to BS PAS 015 1998, BS EN 1384, or ASTM F 1163 95.
3. Riding is a risk sport and it is advisable that all riders wear body protectors to the latest BETA standard.
4. It is compulsory that every person entering upon the Professional Equine Training venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
5. It is compulsory that all dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
6. It is compulsory that horseboxes are not to be mucked out on site.
7. It is compulsory that all gates must be kept closed.
8. The Management of the venue or Professional Equine Training reserves the right to remove anyone from the course at any time without giving a reason.
9. You note and accept there will be a no medical or veterinary cover on site.
10. All schooling may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check on 07962 251 696 before departing.
11. All horses/ponies must be four years old.
12. In the event of a cancellation, entry fees will be returned on receipt of a S.A.E. A £10 admin fee is retained.
13. Withdrawals/cancellations will only have their entry fees returned on receipt of a vet or doctor's certificate and a S.A.E within 7 days of the time of withdrawal. A £10 admin fee is retained.

Personal Injury and Equipment Insurance Notice

The course's owner/instructor or Professional Equine Training does not insure the rider, your horse or your tack and equipment. You are strongly advised to have in place your own adequate personal accident insurance at all times.
